ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS the Third District Bench/Bar Domestic Relations Committee has recommended the adoption of a Joint Preliminary Injunction to be issued in all divorce cases; and,

WHEREAS the Bench/Bar Committee has recommended to the Court a proposed Joint Preliminary Injunction which has been reviewed and approved by the Court; and,

WHEREAS the utilization of a Joint Preliminary Injunction will maintain the status quo as to property, reduce the possibility of conflict as to custody, and prohibit physical harrassment of both parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the attached Joint Priliminary Injunction shall be issued and attached to and made a part of all divorce complaints filed in the Third Judicial District on or after October 1, 1987.
