Whereas this Court has been informed by the Idaho State Bureau of Laboratories that certain precautions must be undertaken regarding the the handling of court exhibits containing human body fluids and human body fluid stains, and

Whereas the provisions of **Idaho Code**, Sections 1-703, 1-1603.5. and the **Idaho Rules of Evidence** provide this Court with the authority to determine the manner in which exhibits may be physically received into evidence,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND THIS DOES ORDER, That exhibits marked and offered into evidence which contain human body fluids and/or human body fluid stains shall be placed in a clear plastic reopenable covering or other suitable reopenable container to reasonably protect court personnel and litigants from being subjected to communicable diseases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the provisions of this administrative order shall be effective immediately.
