Order Amending VERA Point Scale
Release System


WHEREAS, it has come to this Court's attention that the present VERA Point Scale Release System being utilized by the Canyon County Pre-Trial Release Division makes no provision to consider that a defendant has been charged with violating a protection order; and

WHEREAS, the violation of a protection order is considered by this Court and the local judiciary to be a serious matter and worthy of consideration in the process of determining whether or not a defendant should be admitted to a recognizance release;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the VERA Point Scale Release System being used by the Canyon County Pre-Trial Release Division is amended to provide for the subtraction of two (2) points from the VERA point score for any defendant charged with the violation of a protection order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of this Court's Administrative Order 89-2 shall remain in full force and effect.
