ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

87-1

To preserve the security and quiet needed for the orderly operation of the Courts, and to provide an environment that is conducive for the calm deliberation required for jurors, and to comply with the Administrative Order issued by the Idaho Supreme Court on February 16, 1979,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, AND THIS DOES ORDER, that


a) No pictures may be taken and no recording may be used in the Courtrooms or its environs in the Third Judicial District except:

- 1) Those devices used by authorized Court personnel;
- 2) Those photographs of exhibits taken by counsel, or under direction of counsel, as authorized by the Court;
- 3) Those photographs authorized by the Administrative Judge for ceremonial or other appropriate occasions.

b) For purposes of this Order, "environs" means:

- 1) That portion of any building assigned for Court or jury use, including the corridor area adjacent thereto;
- 2) All restricted corridors and other areas used by Judges, jurors, or witnesses within the Courthouse or other building used for said purposes.
